Prof. László Andor, PhD, from 2010 to 2014 the European Commissioner for Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion. From 2005 to 2010, he represented Hungary, the Czech Republic, Slovakia and Croatia on the Board of Directors of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development. He also worked as an adviser to the Hungarian government between 2003 and 2005. László Andor began his studies at the former Karl Marx University (today Corvinus University) in Budapest; it took him via George Washington University in Washington to the University of Manchester, where he obtained a master's degree in 1993. This was followed by stays at King's College in London and at the Royal Academy of Sciences in Holland. László Andor received his PhD from the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.
